YOUR GUIDE TO ARRIVING AT THE JALSA

By the Grace of Allah, the 2007 Jalsa Salana is on its way.

This guide is intended to provide directions to Masjid Bait-ul Huda, for your trip to the Jalsa Salana.

There are 2 sections attached. One is intended for Victoria / South Australia guests arriving from Hume Hwy on the south, and other is intended for Queensland guests arriving from the north.

We would like to fully guide you through our big city, where there have been a number of changes to roads. Some old roads have been closed, or become complicated, and a new motorway 'Westlink M7' has opened up which conveniently goes quite close to Masjid Bait-ul Huda.

The maps attached show two routes for reaching Masjid Bait-ul Huda. One route is via the motorway(s), and the other route is via highways for the guests with no e-tag.

The M7 Motorway is the new toll-road. It links to Hume Hwy from the south, and the M2 Motorway / Pennant Hills Rd from the north.

The toll for Victoria and South Australia guests arriving from south side is \$6.01 and the toll for Queensland guests arriving from the north side is \$2.20 at the Pennant Hills Rd entry into M2 Motorway, and a further \$3.60 for M7 Motorway.

Please note that all users of the M7 require an e-tag. The M2 toll may be paid by cash or e-tag. Many interstate members may already have e-tags, however please contact the company here in Sydney, on 13 72 67, to ensure that your e-tags will be compatible.

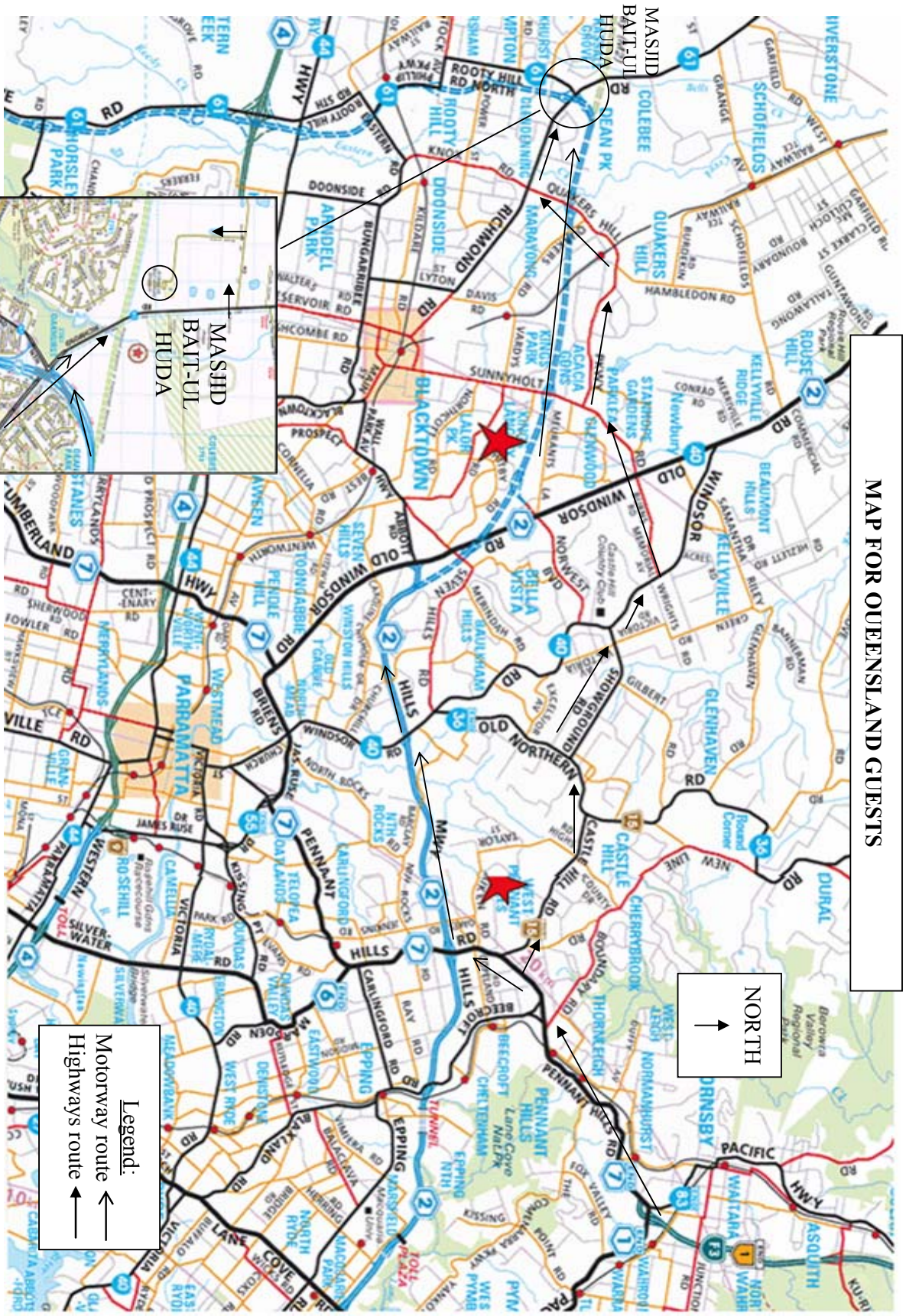

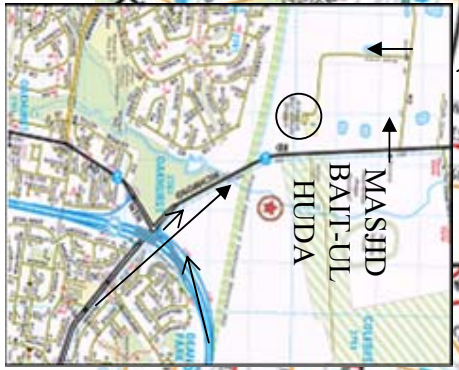
