

11th Annual Ijtema Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya South Australia 2010

Day 1:

By the Grace of Almighty Allah, the 11th Khuddamul Ahmadiyya and Atfalul Ahmadiyya Ijtema of South Australia commenced on Friday, the 6th of August 2010 at 5:00pm in the evening. The Ijtema started with a silent prayer followed by the recitation of the Holy Quran by Qaseem Aslam. Shahid Talpur (Nazim Ilmi Muqabalajaat) started the program with the competition of Bait Bazi followed by the competition of Deeni Maloomat. After Maghrib and Isha Prayers, individual contest of Table Tennis was held among the Khuddam, organised by Kaleem Aslam (Nazim Sehat-o-Jismani).



Saleem Shaukat (Nazim Ta'am) and his team served dinner for the Khuddam and the Atfal after the game. Hamza Khaliq (Nazim Rehaish) had prearranged the stay for the guests as well as the local Atfal and Khuddam at the Aldinga Mission House during the Ijtema.

Day 2:

The 2nd day of the Ijtema started with Tahajjud Prayer on Saturday, the 7th of August 2010. This was followed by Fajr Prayers and a short Dars-ul-Quran. After breakfast, the opening session began.

Opening Session:

Monus Sheikh (Nazim Stage) proceeded with inviting Manzoor Qadir Khan, Sadr Jamaat South Australia to chair the session, which started with the recitation of the Holy Quran by Qamar Ahmad. This was followed by a nazm by Tahir Awan. Qaid Majlis, Fareed Bajwa then read out the Khuddam Ahad with the Khuddam repeating after him. Next, Sadr Jamaat delivered his opening speech in Urdu and ended the speech with a silent prayer for the success of the Ijtema.

Religious competitions were held next, with the Husn-e-Qirat competition taking place first, followed by the Nazm competition and then the speech competition. The competitions ended with Zuhr and Asar prayers.

After the lunch, religious competitions for the Atfal started, which was chaired by Badar Munir. The competitions were organised by Qaseem Aslam (Nazim Atfal) and Hamza Khaliq. Husn-e-Qirat competition was conducted first, followed by nazm, speech, azaan and then religious question and answers. This session ended with Maghrib and Isha Prayers, followed by dinner. After the dinner, a Mushaira was held for Ansar, Khuddam and Atfal.



Day 3:

The third day of the Ijtema once again started with Tahajjud Prayer on Sunday, the 8th of August 2010. This was followed by Fajr prayers and Dars-ul-Quran. After breakfast, the sport competitions of Khuddam and Atfal began with long jump, throw ball, 100 meter race, three-legged Race, tug of war and volleyball. After Zuhr and Asar prayers, the final session of the day started.



Closing Session:

Rana Ejaz, Sadr Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya Australia chaired the final session, which began with the recitation of the Holy Quran and nazm, followed by the Khuddam's Ahad. Qaid Majlis presented the annual report for Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya and Majlis Atfalul Ahmadiyya South Australia, then Ata-ul-Manan Babar; Nazim-e-Aala presented the Ijtema Report and thanked all of his volunteers and participants in making the Ijtema a success. He also thanked Sadr Majlis Khuddamul Ahmadiyya Australia and the other guests from Sydney who took their time out to be a part of the Ijtema.

This was followed by the distribution of prizes among the Khuddam and Atfal. Fareed Bajwa announced the winner of the Alm-e-Inami stating that it was a close competition where both Halqas put hard effort into the whole year. However, the Alm-e-Inami was presented to Halqa Fazl-e-Omar's Zaeem, Khalid Rasheed by Sadr Sahib, Rana Ejaz.

Then Sadr Sahib delivered his concluding speech. He congratulated everyone on the success of the Ijtema and stressed on the importance of Namaz. He also spoke in regards to being obedient to the Jamaat's system. The 11th Annual Ijtema came to a successful end with silent prayers led by Sadr Sahib.
